Alpspitzbahn top terminal is the starting point for this mountain tour. From here, the trail leads uphill towards Alpspitze and Höllentorkopf. After a short period, you will reach a junction where hikers should turn right and follow signposts for Rinderscharte and Höllental. You will arrive at the Höllentor (Gates of Hell) after only a few minutes. Steps secured with wooden poles now take you into the rock face of the Höllentorkopf and steadily downhill over the foothills of the Alpspitze. The path gets stonier and leads downhill over winding bends along the mountain ridge. After around one hour, you will meet up with the trail

from Hupfleitenjoch. It is another 20-minute downhill walk to the Höllentalanger Hut. The trail leads back to Hammersbach alongside the white waters of Höllentalklamm Gorge, from where the rack and pinion railway will transport you comfortably back to Kreuzeck-/Alpspitzbahn Station.

Attention

Requires sure footedness and a good head for heights.
